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## FROM PRINCIPAL'S DESK



The guiding philosophy of AnandaMarga Education system is Neo-humanism. Neo-humanism is the philosophy of innate love and oneness of all things. Studying about the “web of life” helps one to understand the interconnectedness among self, other humans, flora & fauna and the natural environment. Neo-Humanist Education fosters love and welfare for all regardless of caste, colour, language, religion, race or nationality and also for animals, plants and the earth's ecosystem. Children learn these principles both through lessons and practices (through models developed by teachers) as well as by developing their own intuitional feelings about the interconnectedness of all that exists.

### ESTABLISHMENT / ADMINISTRATION

The School property is owned by Anandanagar Development Society bearing Regd No. S/59119/1988-89.

The School is managed by Ananda Marga Pracaraka Samgha, a socio-spiritual charitable society duly registered under West Bengal Societies Registration Act. XXVI of 1961 vide Registration No. S/6086 of 1963-64 having its Global Head Quarters at 527, VIP Nagar, Kolkata – 700100.

Our Primary level education follows co-education system and it is English medium (based on Neo-Humanism) runs under the supervision of Education Relief And Welfare Section (ERAWS) of Ananda Marga Pracaraka Samgha. CBSE guidelines will be followed in upper level classes.

Children of all sects, castes, colour and creed are admitted without discrimination.

### SESSION & SYLLABUS

- The Academic Session of the institute is April to March.
- AnandaMargaGurukulabooks and syllabus is followed in Primary level.
- CBSE syllabus is followed in the Upper level.



## MANAGEMENT

The school is managed by Education Relief and Welfare Section (ERAWS) of AnandaMargaPracarakaSamgha through its structural supervisory workers. Simultaneously a local Advisory Body and Managing Committee also exist for better management and supervision.

 The office remains closed on Sundays and other public holidays.

## RULES FOR ADMISSION

The academic session starts from April. The application form and prospectus can be collected from school office on payment of requisite amount during office-hours. Parents / guardians are required to fill the application form with utmost care. An admission test will be conducted for candidates (from K.G-I to upper classes). The dates of admission tests (which will be held in the school) will be informed to the candidates after the receipt of the duly filled application form. Tests will be done mainly in English, Bengali/Hindi (2nd language), Mathematics, Science and general proficiency. Students seeking admission from other schools must come with proper 'TRANSFER CERTIFICATE'. In case of new students, guardian's declaration of age supported by birth registration certificate or such other authentic document like Affidavit from a court is to be submitted. Aadhaar card of the candidate and Aadhaar card of the parents are to be deposited during admission. Mentally and physically disabled boys or girls will not be eligible for admission.

## RULES REGARDING FEES AND FEES STRUCTURE

Tuition Fees and transportation charges must be deposited within 10<sup>th</sup> day of every month on schedule days during the school time. The fees can also be deposited after the end of a month but defaulters will have to pay a fine of Rs. 50 for every month, both for tuition fee and transportation charges separately. The fees of the month/s when school is on a long vacation such as summer vacation etc. shall have to be deposited before the school closes for the vacation.

Our Academic session starts from April. If anyone gets late admission, then they will have to pay the fees from April itself.

### NORMS REGARDING TIFFIN

The students will have to bring school prescribed vegetarian Tiffin with them daily in tiffin box only. No student should come to school without Tiffin. Students are not allowed to carry money for buying eatables.

### RULES REGARDING LEAVE FOR STUDENTS

- Prior to any leave or absence, application must be submitted to the Manager / Principal / Teacher-in-charge of the School.
- Students must produce a valid medical certificate for remaining absent due to illness.
- Students having contagious diseases should come to school after proper treatment.
- Sick students should get proper treatment at home and after recovery can come to School.

### GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

- Students must come to school in prescribed uniform and with RFID card otherwise they will not be allowed to attend their classes.
- Scheduled time for students' arrival is fifteen minutes before the Meditation Class.
- At the first warning bell, students along with staff must assemble in the Meditation Hall for morning assembly (Circle of Love). After the Meditation, all will walk silently to their classes in queue.
- Every student must feel that the property of the school is his/her own property.
- Bringing toys, crackers or other play materials are not required for study. Therefore they are not allowed in the school campus. Mobile is strictly prohibited for the students.
- If any student by mistake takes home some articles of others, the guardians should return it to the office as the earliest.
- If any student leaves personal items in the school, then the guardian should come to the office to get it.
- No student will be allowed to go home during school hours without a letter from their parent/guardian.
- In case of sudden sickness, the student is allowed to leave school with his/her guardian/parent. Parents must produce their guardian ID to the school authority.
- Every student is required to maintain high moral standard of the school by his/her good manners and behaviors.
- Students need to be well-disciplined, well behaved and well mannered.
- They must come to school in time with proper preparation of lessons.
- Every student must bring his/her school diary.
- Students should come in clean and well ironed school uniform with his/her School ID.
- They should bring prescribed text books and necessary exercise books to their classes.
- Wearing ornaments and make-ups are not allowed in the school.

## EXAMINATION AND RESULT DECLARATION

Class tests will be conducted by the decisions of the subject teacher.

## PROGRESS REPORT

Progress Report is issued to the students on the day of announcement of results. These Progress Reports (for Unit Tests, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Terminal examinations only) must be returned to the office after guardian's signature within 3 days of issuance. Progress Report after Annual exams will be retained by the guardians. One have to pay Rs. 100 for a duplicate progress report.

## IDENTITY CARD

RFID card to the students & guardians will be issued from the school.

## STAFF



Our school administrators, both teaching and non-teaching staff consist of dedicated and moral devoted persons coming from different walks of life. They are active disciplinarians, busy to fulfill "Man making mission". They take care of students' all-round growth i.e. physical, emotional, social, intellectual, moral and spiritual.

## LIBRARY

School library contains books in different languages (Bengali, English and others). Students can enroll themselves in the library and take the books to their homes. Rules of the library are to be followed for taking the books home. They will have to return their books within ten days. A student can take one book only at a time. Anyone can also donate books to the library.



## HOLIDAYS

Our school remains closed on Sundays. For Nursery class it is closed on Saturdays & Sundays. On 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday School remains closed for guardian meeting. Besides there are 65 holidays in a year that include two long vacations – one in Summer and other during the festival days of Saradotsav. Holidays list given separately to the students.

## EDUCATIONAL TOUR

Besides the educational activities inside the campus of our school, students in groups are taken on educational tours to different important places in and around West Bengal. Special attention is given in arranging food, health care, educational learning, conveyance and lodging etc so that students feel comfortable and enjoy the tour.

## PRABHAT SAMGIITA

Prabhat Samgiita is taught to the students in our Prabhat Samgiit Academy. An annual competition on Prabhat Samgiit is held every year in our school. Students showing excellence, take part in the final competition organized at Ananda Marga Head Quarters in Kolkata.



## ANNUAL FUNCTION

The annual function of the School is organized every year during winter season. Almost all the students take part and present dance, drama, recitation, Prabhat samgiita, Ananda Vanii etc. Parents, well-wishers, dignitaries of the locality are invited on this occasion to witness and enjoy the talents of the budding students. Students showing excellence in their performances are encouraged by prizes and certificates.

## COMPUTER EDUCATION

Computer education is the essential part of school education now-a-days. so we have introduced computer education, both theory and practical for our students from class Std-I to Std-VIII as a compulsory subject. No extra fee is charged for computer classes.



## COURSES OF STUDY

Our curriculum comprises English language and literature (First language), Bengali/Hindi (Second language), History, Geography, Mathematics, Computer Science, Students Volunteers, Environmental science, Fine Arts, Music etc. A printed course of study for all classes is given to the students.



### EXAMINATION ANSWER SHEETS CHECKING

Guardians may check the answer sheets of their wards for both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Exams and Unit tests on a particular day which will be declared by school committee, but Annual Exam answer sheets will not be given to the guardians. Guardians may see the answer sheet inside the school upon request through written application.

### GUARDIAN MEETING

All the guardians are cordially invited to this meeting. Guardians can come to this meeting with their proposals and suggestions for developing the school. Co-operation and co-ordination are highly expected from the guardians to maintain proper standard of education and wholistic development of the child. Close relation and good understanding among all the guardians, teachers and school administration is very important for the comprehensive development. Anyone, who remains absent in those meeting will have no rights to make any comment or complain about the resolutions of the meetings. Hence joining the meeting is very important and is reasonably compulsory. For some unavoidable cause if anyone remains absent, then they may inform their written suggestions to the office in advance.

### DAILY ROUTINE

Our school starts with meditation class (Circle of Love) which is held daily in the morning at 8.00 AM (summer time) and 9.00 AM (winter time). Meditation class schedule comprises Prabhat Samgiit, shlokas from Scriptures, Meditation, reciting Ananda Vaniis, taking oath etc.

After 'Circle of Love' academic classes covering English, Bengali/Hindi, Mathematics, History, Geography, Science etc are taught as per School Roster.

Apart from regular subjects, meticulous care and stress is given on moral lessons through Stu-Vol (students' volunteers programme). Stu-vol and play-way method make the learning environment quite joyful and enjoyable.

The Stu-Vol lessons including P.T, Parade, games etc are given special attention. It helps the students to develop service spirits, leadership qualities and other values of life.

### SCHOOL MAGAZINE

The school magazine is published every year in co-ordination with the students, guardians and teachers. All the boys and girls of our school can contribute their self-written poems, short stories and creative thoughts etc. for this magazine. Our teachers also contribute their writings here. The articles may be in three languages i.e Bengali, English and Hindi.



### TRANSPORTATION

We have transportation system to collect boys and girls from different areas of our locality. The transportation fee is collected every month along with monthly Tuition Fee in the cash-counter of the school.

### ANNUAL SPORTS



Annual sports and games are organized every year during the winter season. All children are to participate in these events compulsorily. They are encouraged with prizes and certificates according to their performances. Consolation prizes are given to all the participants. There are events for the guardians too. They are encouraged to participate in these events and receive prizes.

### FINE ARTS' ACADEMY



We have Prabhat Samgiit Academy, affiliated to Nikhil Bharat Sangiit Samity, to develop the Fine art potentials among the children through dance, drawing, recitation, Prabhat Samgiita, Tabla, Rabindra Samgiita etc. Students from both our school and outside come here for learning.

### A NOVEL METHOD OF NURSERY EDUCATION

As the present generation grows intellectually necessity of proper education is felt highly. The first imprint of education begins at Nursery level where play-way method is introduced from preparatory to pre-primary stage. Minimum age for admission to Nursery Classes is 3 years.



## GENERAL REGULATIONS

- Students must attend the school regularly and punctually. Parents and guardians are requested to ensure the same.
- Parents/guardians are requested to see that their wards devote sufficient time at home to prepare the assigned home task. Doing regular home-task is given due consideration at the time of class promotion.
- Any kind of damage done to school property will have to be compensated by the parents either individually or collectively.
- If any student does not mend his/her behaviour, he/ she shall be rusticated from the school.
- Students suffering from contagious or infectious diseases shall not be permitted to attend the school till he/she is recovered fully.
- School dues are to be paid on the notified date/dates.
- Parents/guardians are not permitted to see the teachers/students in their class room.
- They may contact the principal/Teacher-in -charge directly for information and help. Friends and acquaintances are not permitted to meet the students in the school campus.
- No student shall be eligible for promotion to higher class unless he/she registers 75% attendance of the total number of working days of the school in the whole academic year. Parents are particularly requested to take note of this rule.
- Parents are welcome to visit the school and contact personally the Principal/Teacher-in -charge during the specified visiting hours for any queries regarding the progress of their wards.
- Parents are requested to go through the progress report issued to their children and co-operate with the school authorities in rectifying the defects, in any.
- Friends and acquaintances are not permitted to see the students in the school campus.

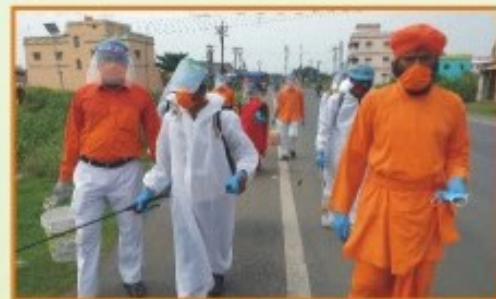
